Welcome to the White Mountain Riding Club! This horse and pony club was established in 1951 by a wonderful group of local horse enthusiasts. Officially incorporated in 1978 and then went on to become a 501c3 non-profit charitable organization in 2016.

WMRC is a small club that hosts a few summer horse shows, a trail ride or two and tries to host a horsemanship clinic each year.

Our club is always looking for new members to join to give their great ideas for fundraising, help with planning an event or even just enjoy horses in general. Plus, we always need volunteers at events!

This club is open to members of all ages, and you do not need to own a horse. If you would like to join, you can fill out the paper membership form or simply go to our website and complete one there! Office staff will always accept membership forms during the horse shows.

The summer shows are free to attend as spectators, come and enjoy the horses and their owners but be mindful to ask permission before touching any horse or pony. Enjoy watching the riders and the horses develop skills as the day progresses. Clapping, cheering and photos are appreciated!

Dogs are best left at home. If you must bring them, please have a copy of the current rabies vaccine paperwork from your veterinarian as well as the dog must be on a leash. Distractive, disobedient, or loud dogs will be asked to leave at show management discretion. Please clean up after your dog.

PLEASE NOTE*** The Friday August show, you must pay the entrance fee to the Lancaster Fair to watch the horse show, but the parking and seating are FREE!

General Information.

<u>For the full version of the rulebook:</u> Quick look guidelines for classes.

Pony/Mini: Open to miniature horses 38 inches and under and any Pony under 14.2 HH. Open to Adult and Youth Handlers.

Green Horse/Pony: Open to all seats. Open to "green" horses and ponies in their first or second year of showing AND that have not cantered/loped at any horse related event that was judged or timed.

Adult Walk/Trot: Open to all seats. Open to riders 18 years and older who have never cantered/loped OR have not cantered/loped in the past three years on any horse at any horse related event that was judged or timed.

Youth Walk/Trot: Open to all seats. Open to riders 17 years old and under who have never shown at the canter/lope OR have not cantered/loped on any horse at any horse related event that was judged or timed.

Youth WTC: Open to all seats. Open to riders 17 years of age and under. WTC division.

Saddle Seat, Hunt Seat and Stock Seat: Open to all riders of any age. WTC division.

Lead line: Open to all riders who cannot show unassisted (off the lead line). There are no age limitations in this division. Can show in all halter classes with an assistant but not required to be attached.

Showmanship: To be judged on showmanship of the posted pattern.

Open Showmanship Championship: Must have shown in a showmanship class to enter. The pattern will be posted online and at the announcer's booth. Ribbons through sixth.

Model: To be shown in hand and judged standing only.

Open Model/ Halter Championship: Must have shown in a model or halter class to enter. May be judged moving at judge's discretion.

\$\$ Jackpot Stake Classes \$\$\$ Divided WT & WTC: Will be judged as a performance or pleasure class at the judge's discretion. 50% of the total entry fees for this class will be divided between the 1st and 2nd placings. Will be asked to back. Ribbons will be awarded through sixth place.

Trail Horse In Hand, WT, WTC & Pony/Mini: Will be judged as separate classes. Trail class will be held outside the ring from approximately 11 AM to 1 PM depending on entries. July weekend & August 4th shows only!

Cross Rails: To be judged on the mount's manners, suitability, and performance. Fences not to exceed 18" in height the 4 fences may be taken at either a trot or a canter at the option of the rider.

Keyhole Barrels: Timed event to do the posted keyhole pattern.

Pattern Classes: To be divided between WTC and WT. Patterns will be posted before the show and online as well as at the announcer's booth. No rail work, individual turns at posted pattern.

MacKennah Caulder Memorial Class: Held only during the August 30th show. There will be special ribbons awarded through 6th place. Presented by MacKennah's family. This class will be divided into WT and WTC. All seats are welcome. Come accented in Pink if you wish MacKennah's favorite color!

Post Entry onetime fee \$10, \$10/ regular class and \$15/ championship class, Office fee per horse/ rider combo \$10

Stalls: \$10 per day or \$20 overnight and overnight camping is \$40 per hook up (water and electricity only)

Health Requirements:

Horses, ponies/ minis:

All horses must have a Copy of a Vet Certified Rabies Certificate – *Dated within 12 months of the show date*.

Copy of Negative Coggins Test-Dated within 12 months of the show date, FOR OUT OF STATE HORSES.

DOGS:

Must have a current Vet Certified Rabies Certificate with the dog while it is on the fairgrounds. This may be asked for. Tags do not count. Must always be on a leash. Not allowed at the show ring or in the grandstands.

Show Points:

Points will be calculated the same day after the division finishes. No Fee No Year End Point Ribbons for 2024. The banquet will be announced at a later date. No Day End Point Ribbons will be award in 2024.

Stalls: During the summer shows, day stalls will be available for \$10 per stall. There will be a \$20 cash deposit that will need to be left at the show office per stall and will be returned after the stall is completely stripped clean of bedding, hay and manure. This is PER STALL!

Showing out of your trailer:

The fairgrounds have asked us to please be courteous and spread out any large piles of manure and to pick up any large amounts of sawdust and hay that may be left behind, please bring to the designated manure pile.

Ages:

ALL equines being shown under saddle must be at least 3 years old as of Jan. 1 of the current year.

Rider's age and Equine age is considered as of January 1 of the current year.

Class Entry Fees are as followed:

Regular class: **\$10** Championship **\$15** Post Entry is a one-time **\$10** per horse/rider combo Pre-Entries will be accepted with a signed blank check or a money order. Returned check fee is \$35.

Lancaster Fair: Our Friday show of Lancaster Fair, day stalls <u>may not</u> be available unless you are showing at the "A Rated Show" and have paid for the weekend.


