### TRAIL MILEAGE LOG RULES

- 1. Be safe!!! Trail Riding and any trail riding events are not covered under WMRC insurance, trail riding is ride at your own risk. WMRC encourages all riders to wear a safety ASTM approved riding helmet and reflective gear.
- 2. The Trail Mileage Log is for riding and driving, adults and kids! You do not have to be a club member to log miles.
- 3. The mileage log is meant for a fun, friendly competition between equine enthusiasts. Please use the log based on the HONOR SYSTEM.
- 4. You can register to log trail miles at any time, however your miles will only count after the date that your registration form and payment has been submitted, miles cannot be backlogged. Trail Mileage recording season ends on December 31<sup>st</sup>. All Trail Mileage logs must be submitted by January 1st to be reviewed and tallied by the WMRC for year end awards. You may either bring the log to a WMRC meeting or mail it to: Casey McMann, 133 Middle St, Lancaster, NH 03584.
- 5. All information must be legible.
- 6. Only one horse/rider combination per Trail Mileage Log.
- 7. Only one horse/rider combination per registration form. A rider may register more than one horse, but must use different logs for each horse.
- 8. There is a \$10.00 registration fee per horse/rider combination. May not cross enter divisions.
- 9. Youth's age as of January 1st.
- 10. If you register in one division, your miles cannot be transferred to another division mid-season. If you need to use more than one log per season please staple the logs together in order.

<sup>\*</sup>Year End Awards will be based on Most Logged Miles, other awards may be given!

#### Trail Divisions are as follows:

**Local Pleasure Division**: Open to riders and drivers who ride on local trails around their farm or home, may attend LOCAL luxury/laid back trail rides hosted by other clubs or organizations. If you trailer or ride to a LOCAL friends house to ride with them on a trail this may be counted on your log.

- Local Pleasure Youth: Under 18 yrs of age
- Local Pleasure Adult: 18 yrs of age and older
- Local Pleasure Driving: Includes horses and minis.
- <u>Senior Horse Local Pleasure</u>: This division is for retired horses over the age of 18 who are in their senior years and may no longer be competitive enough to enter the regular local division but still enjoy trail riding.

**Traveling Pleasure Division**: Open to riders and drivers who <u>mostly trailer</u> (for reasons such as: better or longer trails, larger group #'s, visiting recreational areas or state parks, site seeing, etc.) or who <u>mostly trailer</u> to organized trail rides hosted by clubs or organizations, may attend cowboy races and obstacle challenges. Local pleasure trail riding may also be entered on your log.

- Traveling Pleasure Adult: 18 yrs of age and older
- Traveling Pleasure youth: under 18 yrs of age
